This mystery is a light-hearted mystery that allows your guests to step into different characters while trying to solve the entertaining mystery. The party can be a huge success as long as everyone relaxes and lets the mystery unravel during each round. There will be additional volumes of Fiona Frost mystery parties released so when you have a blast at the first party – she can tell her friends to hang on to their costumes and you can host another Fiona Frost party! To see more of Fiona Frost's world, check out the www.FionaFrost.com website. Direct your guests to view the website prior to the party to be familiar with Fiona and her friends (i.e. the character list). View interesting backgrounds of the characters, the city of Godley Grove, Godley Grove High School, the GGHS Forensic Science Club and more! It can also be used as an educational tool, as it has forensic science pages with great explanations, video selections and even a fun game to play. There are also five award-winning novels, the Fiona Frost Mystery Series. If your child has a blast at the party - <u>check out the Fiona Frost books</u> to continue the fun.

THE ROUNDS ARE DESIGNED AS FOLLOWS:

PRE-GAME STARTER: these pre-game starters are to be delivered to each guest before the party or give them to the guests as they arrive. The pre-game announcements are optional and do not alter the mystery. They set the premise of the game and get your guests excited for your party. These are 'meeting announcements' as if the characters were real, so these should be given to those guests who have already RSVP'd and are assigned a character. These should not be used as actual invitations. There are free downloadable invites on the game's page – scroll to the middle of the page under 'helpful links.'

ROUND ONE: Deliver these clues as your guests arrive. Serve small snacks and mini milkshakes. You can make mystery milkshakes by adding mystery flavors and having your guests 'guess' the mystery flavors! Make cookies and cream, vanilla, pumpkin, lemon, etc. by slightly altering the milkshake recipe from the menu suggestions. The 'Guest Instructions' and the 'List of Characters' should be available for your guests to read when they arrive. You can also take the time to review these materials with your guests before starting the game.

INVESTIGATION ROUND / ROUND TWO: Deliver these clues while you serve a light dinner (optional) to your guests.

FINAL SOLUTION ROUND / ROUND THREE: Cake and hot chocolate can be served during this round as the guests read their final solutions in front of the group. If there is time, accusations can be made by each guest before the Round Three Solution Cards are read (acted out). If you are going to do an awards ceremony (there are multiple types of award certificates available to purchase via instant download on the <u>http://mymysteryparty.com/props</u> Mystery Prop Emporium site), you can base the decision for the Best Actor/Actress award on this round as this is when the guests get to shine and show their acting skills!

- Fiona Frost is smart and clever enough to crack codes. The glass display case holding the treasure map was not broken. Therefore, the thief cracked the code.

- It is strange there were no fingerprints recovered around the broken glass in the main office or on the glass display case. Maybe the thief wore gloves? ESTIMATED PARTY TIMELINE:

(About a 2.5 – 4 hour party depending on the optional games played)

1 week prior: send pre-game announcements 1 week prior to the party.

Time O: when the guests arrive, play any bonus activity (~ 20 min).

20 minutes: go over the game instructions and introduce each character to the group

30 minutes: pass out the Round One envelopes and the mystery investigation sheets (and a pen/pencil for each guest). Instruct Fiona to give the announcement to the group and present the round one forensic evidence that the police gave her prior to the meeting (i.e. the meeting announcement found at the crime scene and the shoeprint evidence). Allow the guests time to mingle (gossip) with their round one clue cards. Serve a light snack.

45 minutes: another bonus activity can be played at this time. (~15 min).

1 hour: to begin round two, give the Round Two clue envelopes, and allow them to mingle (gossip) and discuss their clues on their clue cards and talk about the stolen treasure map.

1 hour 10 minutes: present the coded message. The players discuss the coded message for a moment and then, as everyone is occupied discussing the message, say you just received an anonymous phone call and there's a decoder hidden at the manor. Announce the boundaries for the hunt. When they find the decoder, allow them to work on decoding the message together.

1 hour, 20 minutes: serve dinner (or another snack) to the guests.

1 hour, 40 minutes: play another optional bonus activity (~ 20 minutes).

2 hours: present the forensic evidence for Round Two. Allow the players to have time to consider this evidence and to finish mingling with their Round Two clues. Each guest is to match up (or attempt to match up) their print on their round two card with the fingerprints on the report. If they have a match, they should tell others that they matched.

2 hours, 25 minutes: give Adro Monk the announcement she is to make of who created the coded message. Then, make an announcement that the guests are to submit their final guesses of whodunit.

2 hours, 30 minutes: they are to undergo the round three accusations - each guest will accuse who they believe knows exactly who broke into the Godley Grove Manor and stole the treasure map.

2 hours, 40 minutes: continue round three by serving hot chocolate and dessert (birthday cake) to the guests. The solutions are read by the guests one at a time in front of the group.

3 hours, 10 minutes: finding the stolen treasure map. The boundaries are given to the guests (different from the decoder). They hunt for the map. A prize may be given to the guest who found the map (optional).

3 hours, 25 minutes: another optional bonus activity can be played (~20 min).

3 hours, 45 minutes: present the newspaper article to the guests as the story ender. This newspaper article was released two days after this mystery party. It just gives closure to the story. You can also elect to have your daughter hand this news article out to her friends two days after the party! Maybe if you do thank you cards, it would be fun to slip it into the envelope!

*The party can be shortened by not playing the optional games or extended by adding all of the optional games.
